Takeaways!

- First Bank's Fraud Protection team gave excellent insights into trends they are witnessing and how to avoid them, including check fraud, mail fraud, and credit card fraud.
- Be careful with credit card transaction authenticity and identify matching. Know your customers!
- If you can use other methods of accounts payable such as Positive Pay and ACH Filters, don't use checks if you don't have to! Reconcile the checks you do write and make sure they go to the right vendor and that vendor is legitimate.
- Have a good IT program - update software and email protections faithfully.
- Make Fraud Protection a fundamental part of your business culture and values!!
- Join the Lakewood Business Watch program through Lakewood Police to supply them with helpful contact information and camera locations in the city.
- Get a Crime Prevention evaluation with the city
